The Loch is guarded by the mountains and hills, buzzards, and a golden eagle, that all patrol this stunning place. A hidden watery gem, take the boat trip on the Loch, which is said to be a wonderful experience.


EMBO BEACH

Embo, Sutherland, IV25 3QD



The clean, white sands of Embo beach are backed by a range of stunning sand dunes, with a network of paths to enjoy and a good place to see the spectacular burnet rose. In low tide look out for the ancient anchor rising from the sands, thought to be from a Prussian barque 'Vesta' wrecked in 1876.

Dunvegan Castle is a castle a mile and a half to the north of Dunvegan on the Isle of Skye, situated off the West coast of Scotland. It is the seat of the MacLeod of MacLeod, chief of the Clan MacLeod. Dunvegan Castle is the oldest continuously inhabited castle in Scotland and has been the stronghold of the chiefs of the clan for more than 800 years.
